

Dear applicant:

Thank you for your interest in Puebla Christian School. You may find the background information below helpful as you consider applying for one of our openings—and considering if PCS is a venue where you can use your gifts in ministry.

Puebla Christian School is an independent school with an average enrollment over the past few years of approximately 40 students. We are an ACSI member school. We have students from a number of different denominational backgrounds whose parents are working or ministering here in Puebla. Many students' parents are from the United States or Canada and we also have a number of students from Mexico, South Korea, and a few other Latin American countries.

We currently have nine full-time teachers. So, as you might expect, classes are small. Elementary classes combine the 1st and 2nd grade, 3rd and 4th grade, and the 5th and 6th grade. All the junior high and high school classes are combined for English, history, science, and Bible, with 7th and 8th together, the 9th and 10th together, and the 11th and 12th grades together. All classes are taught in English (except, of course, our offerings in Spanish and French).

In a school our size we get to know parents, and especially the students, well indeed. Not surprisingly, the school has a strong family feel. Our staff is united in a common purpose, passion, and ministry in the lives of our students.

All teachers raise their own support. The school does not pay teacher salaries. The amount of support required varies and is typically set by a teacher's sending mission and the PCS Board. We will assist you either in selecting a mission organization with which you can work if you aren't already doing so or—if you prefer—you can work through your local church. Alternatively, it is possible that you may be able to support yourself. Whatever your situation, though, we will work with you to ensure that your needs here in Puebla are addressed.

Our U.S. and Canadian teachers find moving to Puebla to be a relatively easy transition. It's a city of about 3 million, with an astonishing rich cultural legacy; the downtown area, with more than 2,000 historic buildings, is a World Heritage site. Yet the city is modern too, with upscale malls (if that appeals to you) and stores like Costco, Wal-Mart, and Office Depot. Good medical care is available. As staff get familiar with the city, it is easy to get around by public transportation.

There's much more I could say, and am eager to answer any questions you may have.

If, after prayerfully considering the ministry opportunities at PCS, you would like to apply, please do three things: Complete the application form below; submit a cover letter of one page that indicates your interest in PCS; and attach your resume.

PCS Mission Statement

Puebla Christian School Puebla Christian School provides a Biblically-focused 1st through 12th grade education, with an English-language US-curriculum. PCS serves families seeking a Christian education in an international environment that promotes holistic growth and academic excellence.

PCS Doctrinal Statement

The School Board, Principal, full-time and part-time teachers must annually read and sign the PCS Statement of Faith in order to fulfill the requirements of the PCS constitution and by-laws.

- 1. We believe in the Scriptures of the Old and New Testaments as verbally inspired of God, inerrant in the original writings, and of supreme and final authority in all matters of life and faith.
- 2. We believe in one God eternally existing in three equal persons Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.
- 3. We believe that God the Son became incarnate in the person of Jesus Christ, who was begotten by the Holy Spirit and born of the Virgin Mary, and is true God and true man.
- 4. We believe that the Lord Jesus Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures as a substitutionary sacrifice; and that all that believe in Him are justified on the ground of His shed blood.
- 5. We believe in the resurrection of the crucified body of our Lord, in His ascension into Heaven, and in His present life there for us, as High Priest, Intercessor and Advocate.
- 6. We believe in the personal, bodily, visible, and visible future advent of our Lord Jesus Christ in the glory of His Father to set up in the earth a kingdom in which He shall reign in righteousness and peace.
- 7. We believe that the Holy Spirit is a person, possessed of all the distinctively divine attributes. He is God, He convicts the world of sin, righteousness, and judgment. He regenerates, seals, and sets apart the believer to a holy life. At regeneration He baptizes the believer into the body of Christ, and comes to indwell him permanently and gives gifts to every believer.
- 8. We believe that man was created in the image of God, that he sinned and thereby incurred not only physical death, but that spiritual death which is separation from God; and that all human beings are born with a sinful nature, and in the case of those who reach moral responsibility become sinners in thought, word, and deed.
- 9. We believe that whosoever by faith, apart from works of any kind, receives the Lord Jesus Christ as his Savior is "born from above", and thereby becomes a child of God, "created in Christ Jesus unto good works".
- 10. We believe that all the redeemed are kept eternally secure by the power of God through the new birth, the indwelling, and the intercession of Christ.
- 11. We believe that all born-again believers still possess the fallen Adamic nature in this life, but the God has made full provision whereby His children may be more than conquerors through the Lord Jesus Christ by the power of His Holy Spirit who indwells each one.
- 12. We believe that God heals in answer to believing prayer with or without means in accord with His sovereign discretion and will, and that healing cannot be claimed on the same unconditional basis of faith as salvation is claimed. The fact that God does not heal is not necessarily an indication of unbelief or of sin in the believer's life.
- 13. We believe that the Church in its invisible form is universal the true body and bride of Christ, and that all who are born again are members regardless of organizational affiliation. We believe that Christ ordained the observance of water baptism and the Lord's Supper till He returns.
- 14. We believe in the bodily resurrection of the just and the unjust, the unending blessedness of the saved and unending punishment of the lost.
- 15. We believe in the reality and personality of Satan.
